# **Erectile problems and Sexual Health**

### **Erectile Problems**

- Often called erectile dysfunction
- Common-about half of men between age 40-70 and about 7 in 10 men aged 70 and over
- Cause is usually due to change in blood flow but other conditions too such as Diabetes, Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's disease.
  Some prescribed medication, Alcohol and long distance cycling!

#### **Erectile Problems**

- Improving general health helps i.e. stop smoking, losing weight and exercise, healthy diet and reducing alcohol
- Treatment options-by mouth, injected, into the urethra and vacuum devices
- Treating underlying conditions such as Diabetes etc
- Counselling
- Specialist advice

#### **Erectile Problems**

- Prescribed medication limited on NHS to specific groups e.g. Diabetes, MS, Parkinson's disease, polio, prostate cancer, and pelvic surgery
- Sildenafil (Viagra) now very cheap
- Do talk to us!

- Lifestyle choices
- Contraception and its role in keeping men healthy
- Infections

## **Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs)**

- Commonest in 15-24yr olds. Some studies suggest that 1 in 4 people in this group are infected in some way
- What are they?
- Warts, Chlamydia, Genital Herpes, Gonorrhoea, Hepatitis B and C (small risk in the latter), Syphillis, Pubic Lice, Trichomonas, HIV

#### **STIs**

- What do I look for?
- Discharge from the penis, sore, rash, ulcer or lump on penis or back passage.
- Pain when you have sex
- Pain on passing urine
- Swelling of glands in the groin
